On September 27, 2017, Officer Nestor Garcia was conducting a felony traffic stop on US 59 North when he was struck and hit by a vehicle. He was dragged by the vehicle approximately 30 yards and he sustained major head and internal injuries. Officer Garcia was transported to the hospital and underwent multiple major surgeries for his injuries. Due to the severity of his injuries, Officer Garcia is facing months of recovery and rehabilitation. Officer Garcia joined the department approximately 18 months ago as a member of Academy Class 226. He is a young officer whose career had just begun. So, please join the South Central Division in its efforts to assist Officer Garcia during this difficult time. A benefit will take place in his honor.
